

Method for installing cable trays in distribution boxes

Step 3: Determine Support and Spacing Install mounting brackets, wall arms, or ceiling struts at regular intervals, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load (). Ensure supports are level and aligned with the tray route. For multi-layer installations, maintain a vertical clearance of at least 30 cm between trays to avoid interference between electrical and communication cables ().

Step 4: Install the Tray Cut trays to required lengths using a hacksaw or angle grinder and deburr edges (). Connect tray sections using couplers or splice plates. Secure trays to supports with appropriate clamps or bolts, ensuring they are straight and level (). For bends, tees, or risers, use pre-fabricated fittings and ensure smooth cable transitions.

Step 5: Bonding, Grounding, and Cable Pull Ensure all trays are properly bonded and grounded according to NEC Article 392 (). Pull cables carefully, maintaining recommended fill ratios (usually max 50%) to prevent overheating and mechanical...
