- Depth/Height:** Varies from 25 mm to 150 mm for channel trays, and higher for ladder trays to accommodate heavy cables.
- Length:** Standard lengths are usually 2–3 meters, allowing modular installation.
- Material Thickness:** Determined by load requirements and tray type, ensuring structural integrity.

Materials and Surface Treatments

Cable trays are commonly made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with surface treatments like galvanization or powder coating to enhance corrosion resistance. Material selection depends on environmental conditions, such as indoor, outdoor, or corrosive industrial settings.
