Installation Practices Affecting Cable Length Figure-8 loops: During installation, cables are often laid in figure-8 patterns with loops of 2-4 meters to prevent twisting and mechanical stress . Excess fiber: Loose tube cables usually include 2-8% extra fiber to allow for splicing and thermal expansion, while ribbon cables may have minimal excess . Vertical or aerial runs: Cables should be clamped at intervals to prevent sagging or exceeding long-term tensile limits, which may require slightly longer cable lengths to accommodate support points . Summary For most outdoor installations, the cable length should match the measured distance plus a 10% safety margin, with additional allowances for loops, splicing, and support structures. Singlemode cables are preferred for long-distance backbones, while multimode is suitable for shorter connections. Proper planning ensures durability, signal integrity, and easier future upgrades.
