

Protective Installation of Top-Level Distribution Box

Ensure the box is level and stable, with permissible vertical deviations of 1.5–3 mm depending on size.

Wiring and Electrical Protection Turn off the power before wiring. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load. Maintain neat cable management, secure connections, and proper insulation. All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress. Include protective devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, surge protectors, and RCDs, with each circuit individually protected. Ground the metal enclosure, electrical board, and all metallic components inside the box, and ensure the protective neutral wire is reliably connected.

Enclosure Selection Choose the enclosure material based on the environment: steel for durability in tough conditions, plastic or fiberglass for lightwe...
