An IP65-rated cabinet is commonly used, providing dust-tight protection and resistance to water jets . This ensures internal breakers, terminals, and wiring remain dry and reliable. Socket and Connector Requirements CEE sockets (IEC 60309) are standard for industrial and outdoor use, supporting single-phase (blue) and three-phase (red) power . Sockets must match the voltage and amperage requirements of connected equipment . Proper labeling and documentation of connections help prevent misuse and facilitate maintenance . Installation and Safety Practices Elevated mounting reduces cable clutter and trip hazards . Bushings or smooth surfaces must be used where flexible cords pass through openings to prevent damage . Only authorized personnel should remove covers or perform maintenance . Temporary wiring should be removed immediately...
