- Mounting:** Use firm and reliable fixing methods such as wall brackets, screws, or pedestals. Ensure the mounting substrate can support the box and equipment weight, and consider vibration isolation if near motors or machinery.
- Level and stable installation:** Maintain vertical deviation within 1.5 mm for boxes under 50 cm and 3 mm for taller boxes. Ensure cable entry holes are smooth, burr-free, and properly insulated.

Wiring and Safety Requirements

- Power off during wiring:** Always disconnect power before installation to ensure safety.
- Wire specifications:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas meeting load requirements. Follow standard color codes for three-phase systems: Phase A - Yellow, Phase B - Green, Phase C - Red, Neutral - Light Blue, Protective Earth - Yellow/Green bi-color.
