

Requirements for Indoor Optical Cable Reel Installation

A minimum crew should include one person at the reel, one at the pulling equipment, and one coordinating the installation. Orientation: Ensure the reel is positioned so the cable feeds smoothly, avoiding sharp bends or twists. Center-pull or backfeed techniques may be used depending on the installation layout. Technical Considerations Pulling Tension: Pull cables only by the manufacturer-specified strength members (e.g., aramid yarn) unless the jacket is approved for pulling. Do not exceed the maximum pulling tension rating. Bend Radius: Maintain the minimum bend radius during pulling (typically 20 times the cable diameter under tension) and after installation (10 times the diameter). Avoid kinking or sharp bends that can damage fibers. Lubrication: Use cable-compatible lubricants when pulling through conduits to reduce friction and prevent fiber damage. Intermediate Supports: For vertical or long runs, clamp the cable at intervals to prevent excessive weight o...
