For outdoor installations, ensure the box has an appropriate IP rating (e.g., IP66 or higher) to protect against dust and water ingress. Maintain sufficient working space around the box, typically enough for two people to work simultaneously, and ensure passageways allow safe maintenance and emergency access.

Mounting and Fixing The distribution box must be firmly fixed to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or collision. Use suitable mounting brackets or screws, and ensure the box is level and stable, with permissible vertical deviations of 1.5 mm for boxes under 50 cm and 3 mm for taller boxes. Cable entry points should be smooth, burr-free, and fitted with insulating bushings to prevent wire damage.
