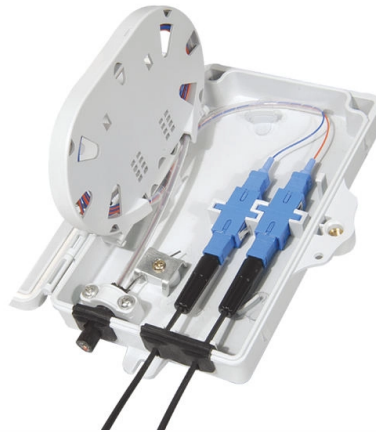


Sampling Principle of Relay Protection Circuit
