Output from Secondary Box: Use the secondary box's output terminals or busbars to feed the tertiary box. Ensure the wiring matches the voltage and phase requirements of the tertiary box.

Circuit Protection: Each tertiary box should have its own RCD and single-phase circuit breakers. The secondary box may also include upstream protection to form a two-tier protection system.

Cable Routing: Use appropriately rated cables for the distance and load. For outdoor or construction sites, ensure rainproof and durable cable routing.

Safety Compliance: Follow the principle of "one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock," ensuring no single switch controls multiple devices.

Testing: After connection, verify voltage, phase sequence, and RCD operation before energizing the tertiary box.

Practical Tips

- Label all connections clearly to avoid confusion during maintenance.
- Ensure the secondary box has sufficient capacity to handle the combined load of all connected tertiary boxes.
- Maintain proper grounding and bonding.
