Single-conductor wires can be installed in cable trays if they meet NEC Article 392 requirements, are appropriately sized, and follow proper support, spacing, and ampacity guidelines. NEC Compliance and Cable Types According to NEC Article 392, single-conductor cables such as THHN/THWN, XHHW, and RHH/RHW are permitted in cable trays, but only if they are 1/0 AWG or larger and marked for tray use. Ground conductors must be larger than 4 AWG, though they do not require marking for tray use. Smaller single conductors (10 AWG and below) are generally not allowed directly in trays unless installed within a secondary product, such as a raceway or channel system, that provides additional support and protection ().

Tray Selection and Support Cable trays come in various types—ladder, ventilated trough, solid-bottom, and wire mesh—each offering different levels of support and ventilation. Ladder trays are ideal for large single-conductor power cables due to excellent ventilation and convenient tie points. Ventilated troughs provide continuous support for smaller cables that may sag between rungs. Solid-bottom trays offer maximum protection but limit heat dissipation, which affects ampacity ().

Installation Best Practices **Spacing and Securing:** Single conductors must be laid in an organized manner and secured at regular intervals to prevent sagging or mechanical damage. Excessive bending should be avoided to maintain insulation integrity (). **Cable Fill:** Tray fill should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area to allow proper heat dissipation and prevent overheating (). **Segregation:** Power and signal cables should be separated to reduce interference and maintain safety. **Ampacity Derating:** When multiple single conductors are installed in a tray, their ampacity may need to be derated according to NEC guidelines to account for heat buildup ().
