

Size requirements for installation openings of distribution boxes

Internal Clearance: Ensure sufficient internal volume for wire splicing, device installation, and future maintenance. Deeper boxes are preferred when multiple wires or devices are present to avoid overcrowding.

Grounding: All metal parts, including the box, electrical board, and appliance casings, must be properly grounded.

Cable Entry: Cable inlets should be sealed with no visible gaps, and the cross-sectional area of wires must meet load requirements.

Protection Devices: Install breakers, fuses, or residual current devices (RCDs) for each circuit to ensure safety.

Special Considerations

Environment: Avoid humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated areas. For outdoor or industrial installations, select boxes with appropriate IP/NEMA ratings.
