Typical equipment includes branch circuit breakers, branch fuses, isolating switches, and leakage protectors. Secondary boxes are designed for three-phase power distribution, often with dual-door protection, powder-coated exteriors, and rainproof tops for outdoor use. They form part of a two-layer protection system, with RCDs installed both here and at the tertiary level.

Tertiary Distribution Box (Third-Level) The tertiary distribution box, also known as the switch box, is the final connection point for individual electrical equipment or groups of similar devices. It is closely connected to the equipment and may be fixed or portable. Each tertiary box typically controls one device or one group of devices, following the principle of "one machine, one sw...
