

Standard Requirements for Installation of Distribution Box Circuits

- Residual Current Devices (RCDs) / RCBOs:** Protect against earth faults and leakage currents, reducing the risk of electric shock. RCBOs combine overcurrent and leakage protection in a single device.
- Fuses:** May be used for additional protection in certain circuits.
- Surge Protective Devices (SPDs):** Protect connected equipment from voltage spikes caused by lightning or switching events. Type 1 SPDs are installed at the service entrance, Type 2 at distribution level, and Type 3 at equipment level.

Design and Installation Requirements

- Accessibility:** Distribution boards must be readily accessible for operation, inspection, and maintenance. Recommended mounting height is 1–1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users.
- Clearances:** Adequate working space around the panel is required for safe access to components.
- Environmental Protection:** Panels should be installed in dry, dust-free areas. Outdoor installations require enclosures with appropriate IP/NEMA ratings (e.g., IP54 or higher) to protect...
