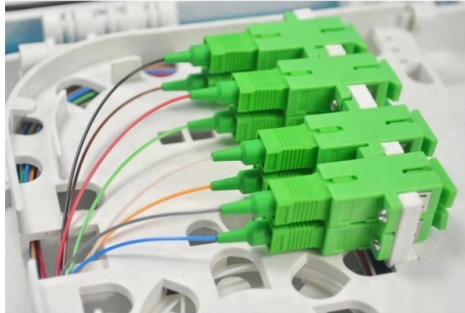


Surge protection installation method for distribution boxes



AI Overview

Install surge protection devices (SPDs) in a layered approach with short, direct leads, proper grounding, and overcurrent protection to ensure effective protection of distribution boards and downstream equipment.

SPD Types and Placement

Type 1 SPD: Installed at the service entrance or upstream of the main distribution panel to handle high-energy surges, including lightning strikes. These devices are rated for 10/350 μ s waveforms and are often installed upstream or downstream of the electricity meter if external lightning protection exists ().

Type 2 SPD: Installed at distribution boards or sub-panels to protect branch circuits from residual surges and switching transients. Rated for 8/20 μ s waveforms, they are the standard choice for most commercial and residential distribution boards ().

Type 3 SPD: Installed near sensitive equipment such as servers, PLCs, or medical devices. They provide the final layer of protection at the point of use ().

Wiring and Lead Requirements

Keep SPD leads as short and straight as possible, ideally under 0.5 m and never exceeding 1 m in total length (sum of all connection lengths) to minimize voltage drop and parasitic inductance (). Use twisted or tie-wrapped leads if longer runs are unavoidable to reduce electromagnetic interference (). Ensure correct polarity and voltage rating matching the distribution system to prevent device failure ().

Grounding and Bonding

Connect SPDs to a single-point grounding system bonded to all available electrodes, building steel, metal water pipes, and driven rods to maintain low ground impedance (). Type 1 SPDs should be connected directly to the main grounding electrode system to safely divert high-energy surges ().

Overcurrent Protection

SPDs must be protected against overcurrent using an MCB or in-built fuse, separate from the main supply fuse, to prevent supply interruption in case of SPD failure (). The ov...
