Each device has a dedicated fiber link to the core switch, reducing collisions and improving performance. SFP Modules: Ensure that the switches have compatible SFP or SFP+ ports. If a switch lacks SFP ports, a fiber media converter can be used to integrate fiber and copper cabling. Port Settings: Fiber ports often require manual configuration of speed and duplex. Auto-negotiation is limited for fiber, especially for 10Gb modules. For example, some EXOS switches may default to 1Gb speed and require manual configuration to 10Gb for SFP+ modules. Port Channels: For redundancy and higher bandwidth, configure port channels (link aggregation) on both ends of the fiber link. Ensure the port channel mode is compatible with the switch firmware and module capabilities. Fibre Channel Port Configuration For Fibre Channel (FC) interconnections, especially in SAN environments: Switch Modes: Fabric interconnects can operate in end-host (NPV) mode or switch mode. End-host mode pins vHBAs to uplink ports and avoids loops, while switch mode allows direct connection to storage devices and uses traditional FC switching. Port Types: FC interfaces can be configured as E ports (expansion ports for ISLs), F ports (connected to hosts), NP ports (in NPV mode), or SD ports (downstream devices). Auto mode can detect the port type during initialization. Speed and Generation: Ensure the FC module supports the desired speed (2, 4, 8, or 10 Gbps)...
