Verify Connection: Test the grounding system to ensure resistance is within safe limits (typically below 25 ohms) and that all connections are tight and corrosion-free. Alternatives if No Ground is Present If a direct ground connection is not available, you can: Install a GFCI (Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter): A GFCI protects against electric shock by detecting current imbalances, even without a physical ground. Mark the receptacle with "No Equipment Ground" and "GFCI Protected". Use Metal Conduits or Boxes: If the wiring uses metal conduit or armored cable, the metal enclosure can serve as a grounding path. Connect the ground terminal of the distribution box to the metal box with a short copper pigtail. Safety Precautions Ensure all connections are secure and clearly labeled for maintenance.
