Pulling methods: Use pulling tape, breakaway pulling eyes, or automated pullers; never pull on the fibers directly . Tension control: Avoid exceeding the cable's maximum pulling load to prevent damage . Spooling: Roll cable off the spool carefully to prevent twisting or kinking .
