Overview of Tonga Cable Limited Tonga Cable Limited (TCL) is a state-owned enterprise responsible for managing Tonga's submarine fiber optic cable system, which connects Tonga to Fiji and links to the Southern Cross Cable Network . TCL was formed in 2009 and commissioned the 827-kilometre Tonga-Fiji submarine cable in August 2013 . The cable significantly improved internet capacity, reduced latency, and lowered wholesale prices for bandwidth in Tonga . TCL is currently the only provider of fiber optic services in the country. Ownership and Partnerships TCL is jointly owned by the Tongan government (66.6%), Tonga Communications Corporation (16.7%), and Digicel Tonga Limited (16.7%) . The company works with international partners for cable manufacturing and repair, including sourcing specialized submarine cable segments from overseas when needed . For example, after the 2022 Hunga Tonga-Hunga Ha'apai volcanic eruption, TCL coordinated the replacement of damaged cable segments, which required new cable to be manufactured abroad .
