- Test Each Circuit:** Turn off one breaker at a time and verify which outlets or devices lose power to ensure accurate labeling.
- Avoid Temporary Tape:** Do not use masking tape, as it can peel or fade over time.
- Include Additional Notes:** For multi-use circuits or special equipment, add notes to clarify coverage, e.g., “Bathroom GFCI + hallway outlet”.
- Maintain Consistency:** Use the same numbering and labeling style across all panels in the building for easy reference.

Recommended Label Types

- Vinyl Stickers:** Tear-resistant, waterproof, and writable for circuit directories.
- Numeric Stickers:** Useful for high-volume panels with many circuits.
- Reusable Labels:** Some vinyl labels can be repositioned if circuits are modified or added.
