- IP54:** Offers dust protection (not completely dust-tight) and splash protection from any direction. This is widely recommended for indoor distribution boxes in commercial or industrial environments where occasional moisture or cleaning sprays may occur.

- IP55/IP65:** Fully dust-tight and resistant to water jets. These are more robust options for areas with higher humidity or potential water exposure, such as near HVAC systems or damp utility rooms.

Selection Guidelines

Indoor Environment Assessment: Determine the likelihood of moisture exposure, such as condensation, cleaning, or accidental splashes.

Dust Consideration: Even indoor environments can accumulate dust, which may affect electrical performance. Ratings of 5 or 6 for solids are preferred.

Compliance and Safety: Ensure the enclosure meets IEC 60529 testing standards, which define the conditions for dust and water ingress tests.
