MEMS (Micro-Electro-Mechanical Systems) Switches MEMS switches employ microscopic mirrors or moving waveguides on a chip to direct optical signals. They allow large switching matrices, compact design, and rapid switching (microsecond response times), but typically handle limited optical power and have moderate insertion losses.

Optomechanical Switches Optomechanical switches combine mechanical movement with optical precision, often using mirrors or shutters to control light paths. They are highly reliable and precise, commonly used in network protection and scenarios requiring minimal insertion loss.
