- Virtual Private Networks (VPNs) and Secure Gateways** VPNs encrypt communications between remote users and government networks, ensuring secure access for authorized personnel. Secure gateways provide additional filtering and threat mitigation at network entry points.
- Endpoint Security Devices** These include antivirus software, anti-malware tools, and endpoint detection and response (EDR) systems installed on government computers and mobile devices to prevent compromise.
- Unified Threat Management (UTM) Appliances** UTM devices combine...
