ST (Straight Tip) ST connectors feature a cylindrical shape with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism. They are durable and reliable, suitable for legacy systems, industrial networks, and campus installations. ST connectors use a 2.5mm ferrule and are primarily found in multimode fiber applications, though they are less common in new installations.

FC (Ferrule Connector) FC connectors have a threaded coupling, providing secure connections in high-vibration environments such as factories, railways, or aviation systems. They are mostly used with single-mode fibers and are valued for low insertion loss and high return loss in precision networks.

MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On) MPO and MTP connectors are designed for high-density, high-bandwidth applications, accommodating multiple fibers (12, 24, or 36) in a single rectangular ferrule. MTP is...
