In contrast, a patch cord has connectors on both ends and is used for direct connections between devices or panels.

Applications of Pigtails

- Splicing into bulk fiber cables:** The bare end of the pigtail is fused to the incoming fiber, creating a permanent, low-loss joint.
- Connecting to equipment:** The connector end allows easy connection to transceivers, patch panels, or ODF ports.

Single-mode and multimode networks: Pigtails are widely used in both single-mode and multimode fiber deployments, including 10G networks with OM3 or OM4 fibers.

Conclusion While a pigtail is technically an optical fiber cable, it cannot replace a full-length fiber optic cable for transmitting signals over distance. Its primary purpose is to provide a reliable, factory-terminated connection point for splicing into longer fiber cables, ensuring high-quality network terminations and reducing installation time and errors.
