

What to do if a single-mode fiber optic module is not emitting light

- Module Health and Compatibility**The module itself may be defective or incompatible with the device. Check the module's DDM/DOM parameters such as optical power, wavelength, and distance. If alarms appear or parameters are out of range, the module may need replacement. Using non-certified or third-party SFPs can also lead to unpredictable behavior .
- Physical Fiber Issues**Even if the module is functional, the fiber may have breaks, bends, scratches, or contamination. Dirt or dust on the connector end-face can block light emission. Inspect and clean connectors, and verify the fiber is intact and properly connected . Excessive bending or stress can also cause signal loss.
- Testing and Verification**For single-mode modules, the emitted light is invisible, so visual inspection is not sufficient. Use a fiber-optic tester or power meter to verify light output. Loopback testing by connecting the Tx and Rx ports with a compatible jumper can help confirm module functionality .
