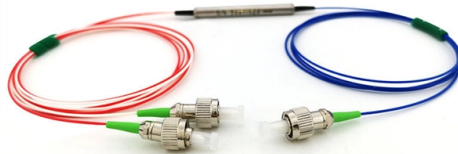


Where is the fiber optic port plug on the switch

If the switch supports hot-swapping, the module should be detected automatically; otherwise, you may need to configure the switch to recognize the new module. Additional Tips Handle SFP modules and fiber cables carefully to avoid damaging the delicate optical components. Ensure the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) matches the SFP module specifications. For short-distance connections within a building, multi-mode fiber is usually sufficient, while single-mode fiber is used for longer distances. By following these steps, you can correctly locate the fiber optic port on your switch and establish a secure fiber connection, enabling high-speed data transmission over longer distances than standard copper Ethernet.
