The distribution box should be installed in a dry, accessible location with good ventilation, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Installation Best Practices Turn off the main power before wiring. Use a voltage tester to confirm the power is off. Plan the wiring layout to accommodate all circuits without crowding the box. Install circuit breakers according to the load requirements of each circuit. Label each breaker clearly for easy identification and future maintenance.
