- Low-Voltage Wiring:** Properly insulated and routed to prevent short circuits and ensure safe distribution to residential or commercial loads.
- Drainage and Ventilation:** Transformer pits or underground boxes require drainage systems, submersible pumps, and ventilated tops to prevent water accumulation.
- Panel Configuration:** Outdoor panels may include LT distribution panels, load management panels, marshalling panels, and power control panels, all designed for safe outdoor operation.
- Installation and Maintenance:** Qualified Personnel: Only licensed electricians should perform installation, with supervision by a PNG-licensed electrician on-site at all times.
- Periodic Inspections:** All outdoor distribution boxes are subject to periodic inspection...
