- Protective Neutral Wiring:** The neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board, ensuring proper operation of RCDs and balanced circuits.
- Wire Selection:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. Proper insulation and neat cable management prevent exposure and reduce fire risk.
- Circuit Segregation:** Each circuit should have its own protective device, and wiring should be organized to avoid confusion and facilitate maintenance.
- Power Off During Installation:** Always turn off the main supply before wiring to prevent electric shock.
