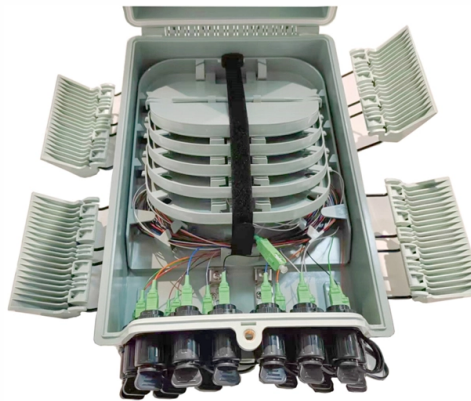

Align the connector ferrule with the panel adapter and gently insert it until it clicks or locks into place. Ensure the fiber is not bent sharply and that the cable is properly routed to avoid stress on the connection (Wiring Work). Use cable management clips or trays to secure the fiber and maintain bend radius.

Step 4: Test the ConnectionAfter installation, test the fiber connection using an optical power meter or visual fault locator to confirm signal integrity. Proper alignment and clean terminations are critical to minimize insertion loss and reflection (Cable Matters).
